

Building “Choice” Signs

CBR is dedicated to exposing the sin of abortion so that our nation will become convicted to stop the killing. We are very thankful for your help in being a witness for truth in your community. Below are instructions on how to construct a handheld “CHOICE” sign so that you may effectively reveal the harsh reality of “choice.” Thanks again for being a bold testimony against the killing of unborn children.

Step 1.

Find a local sign company in your community (e.g. Sign-O-Rama) and purchase a sheet of corrugated plastic board. 1/4 inch thick is good, but 3/8 inch thick is better. A sheet of corrugated plastic board is usually 4’ X 8’ and can cost between \$20-40 per sheet. The sign company may cut you a 3’ X 4’ sheet at an additional charge.

Step 2. Before applying the self-adhesive vinyl sign to the corrugated plastic board, you must clean the corrugated plastic board and remove any dirt.

Step 3. Fill a spray bottle with water and add one drop of dish soap. Shake thoroughly.

Step 4. Unroll the “Choice” sign and lay it out on your sign board **without removing the backing.** Center the sign on the board, and tape one of the short edges of the sign to the board with masking tape.

Step 5. Fold back the sign from the board. You will be opening it like a big book.

Step 6. Peel the backing off of the sign. Be careful not to let the sign stick to itself

Step 7. Spray the soap/water mix on the board and on the back (sticky side) of the sign. Spray it thoroughly. The water will keep the sign from sticking to the board and to itself. The soap keeps the water from beading up and running off.

Step 8. Next, “close the book.” Fold the wet sign over onto the wet board using the tape as a hinge. You won’t have to worry about the sign sticking to itself or large bubbles and wrinkles at his point. After you get the sign laid in place adjust it to get as many wrinkles out as you can.

Step 9. After the sign is centered and applied to the board, make a squeegee from a small scrap of cardboard (about 4-5” long). Bend the piece of cardboard to make the squeegee. Wrap it in a paper towel or rag so it will not scratch the sign. Start in the center of the sign and use the squeegee to flatten the sign wrinkles and push out the water that is under the sign. Use small gentle strokes as you work outward. Make sure that all the water is removed from between the sign and board before allowing the sign to dry.

Step 10. When all the water is removed from between the board and sign, let the sign dry overnight or for 24hrs. When it is dry the edges will stick down with a gentle rub.

Step 11. After the sign is dry, go to your local high school, abortion mill, or college campus to educate your community about what abortion does to preborn babies.
