On May 17, 2013, Biola University senior nursing student Diana Jimenez was threatened with arrest and expulsion, just days before her graduation, for intentionally breaking a rule which prohibits the display of abortion photos on her Christian college campus. Biola had ordered her to take down a similar display the previous week. The second time, she respectfully refused to comply with police demands. The director of nursing subsequently ordered the nursing professors to NOT give Diana letters of recommendation. In spite of all this harassment, Diana stood strong, and at least one baby was saved when a pregnant student saw Diana and her sign. Three months later, on August 20, 2013, Biola President Barry Corey issued a public apology to Diana and in February 2014, President Corey announced that Biola has rewritten their policies to permit the display of abortion photos on Sutherland Way between the small fountain and the Bell Tower. While we are hopeful that progress has been made, CBR knows this policy must now be tested by students.
