## Victories in 2022

*It is time for our annual CBR Communiqué filled with victories with which God has blessed CBR in 2022. Here are some reports of what is made possible by your faithful support of our ministry.*

### CBR Pakistan Saves a Baby in November

**C**BR-Pakistan conducted 12 pro-life education campaigns throughout the year and they plan one more for December. They are reaching hundreds of women who are vulnerable to abortion. At the end of a November campaign, a woman shared this poignant news:

“I have an appointment next Monday for an abortion because of my family's pressure. They think we can't afford a baby now, but I think today's message is for us, and God sent your team for my counselling. I don't know how I'll motivate my husband, but I'm not going to kill my baby.”

Other than CBR, there is virtually no anti-abortion activism in Pakistan. Please pray for our director as he risks dangerous persecution.

### CBR Summer Intern Program a Success

**T**he 2022 Summer Intern program was a tremendous success. Our students gave us feedback on surveys they completed at the end of their summer of training and activism in several states:

“I learned a lot about how to deal with conflict, worldviews, and just how to live life for the glory of God.”

“Through the apologetics training, book studies and personal experience, I feel like I received a rigorous course in the pro-life movement and the culture.”

“I didn't want summer to end.”

### CBR-Sweden is the Leading Group in Sweden

**O**ur affiliate is the leading pro-life group in Sweden. We conducted sign displays in several locations through 2022, including 21 in Stockholm. Their signs generated many conversations with young people.

## GAP at ASU Leads to Volunteer Recruitment and Training

One of the positive results of our Genocide Awareness Project at Arizona State University in October 2022 is that CBR-Southwest Director Abra Singleton was able to speak with two Christian club members who want to sponsor GAP's return in the Spring. Additionally, the club at University of Arizona (Tucson) wants to bring in GAP this Spring. Mrs. Singleton was able to train both students in our pro-life apologetics training the next weekend.

## Two New Teams Launched by CBR - UK

Our UK affiliate is growing and reaching people around the country. They reported this month: "Exciting news - two new teams launched on two opposite sides of the country. Our Scotland Central Belt team launched at the end of October, and our Devon team mid-November." This is CBR-UK's first team in Scotland, and this work is critical. Since the passage of the 1967 Abortion Act, over half a million babies have been killed by abortion; this is the entire population of Edinburgh.

## ETSU GAP Prompts Lost Student to Call Christian Grandma

The President of the Turning Point – USA at Eastern Tennessee State University (ETSU) invited GAP on campus November 2-3. There were many protestors during the CBR display, but our staff member Jane Bullington was able to speak at length with “Allie,” a student who had gone to Catholic school for 12 years, but had become an atheist and bisexual. Allie shared that “weird” things keep happening to her, and she wonders if it has to do with Jesus. Since Mrs. Bullington reminded Allie of her Christian grandma, Allie decided to call her and ask to go to church with her at Thanksgiving. She returned two hours later to tell Mrs. Bullington that she had spoken to grandma for an hour and a half and her grandma still loves her. God continues to use CBR to bring many types of healing.

## CBR-Netherlands Holds Parliament Accountable

Our affiliate held Parliament accountable in June 2022 as they displayed abortion and prenatal photo signs while Senators discussed eliminating the 5-day waiting period for abortion and allowing family doctors to prescribe the abortion pill. CBR-Netherlands also delivered educational boxes to members of both Houses of Parliament. The boxes contained fetal models and pro-life literature. One political party responded when they received their box, “What a moving moment when we opened the box ... [it is] wonderful that you have done this.” Another secular political party invited CBR Founder Salome van der Wende to come speak to them, and during her presentation

many party members responded to the abortion photos with: “That’s murder.” Until Parliament voted these destructive measures into law, abortion had been only legal in abortion clinics or hospitals.
