CBR Truck Rolled in the People's Convoy

A key component of CBR's strategy is to use cultural and political events and trends to the pro-life advantage. We learned that U.S. truckers were motivated to follow the example of courageous Canadian truckers who drove across Canada to take a stand for freedom and against medical and religious tyranny. Canadian truckers opposed a new Canadian mandate that would force all truck drivers to take COVID vaccines just to cross the US//Canadian border. We decided it would be an excellent opportunity for CBR to join in the U.S. People's Convoy which began in Adelanto, California on Wednesday, February 23. One of our trucks was positioned in Arizona, so we moved in two volunteers drivers to join the convoy in Kingman, Arizona.



We sent a CBR truck to travel across the U.S. with the People's Convoy. This was a tremendous opportunity to educate millions of people with our prenatal and abortion photos. Thousands of well-wishers

spontaneously came out to wave flags in support of this convoy for freedom. CBR's strategy relies on freedom of speech, and we are constantly working to protect it. Left photo was taken along Interstate 44. Our truck is number two in the convoy of trucks east of Kingman, Arizona.

The People's Convoy consisted of hundreds of semi-trucks, but also medium-sized commercial trucks like our 24-foot box body truck, RV's, pick-up trucks and various vehicles. Our truck displayed our beautiful prenatal photos on one side, and on the other side and the rear were abortion photos signs and "Vote Pro-life." Readers will recall that in 2021, we featured two articles detailing the disturbing reality that all vaccines available in the U.S. were manufactured using aborted fetal cells, or through testing on aborted fetal cells. If any pro-life person is forced to accept those vaccines, that is a violation of conscience.

The route for the People's Convoy was:
Wednesday, February 23 – Depart Adelanto Stadium; CA,
February 24 – Depart Kingman, AZ; February 25– Depart Lupton, AZ; February 26 – Depart Glenrio, TX; February 27 – Depart Elk City, OK; February 28 – Depart Vinita, OK; March 1 – Depart Sullivan, MO; March 2 – rest day Indianapolis, IN; March 3 – Depart Indianapolis, IN;

March 4 – Depart Cambridge, OH; March 5 – Depart Hagerstown, MD – Arrive in the DC Beltway area.

Our volunteer drivers reported that response to our photo signs truck was hugely positive, both from others in the convoy as well as supporters lined up along the highways. A woman told us, "You have the most important truck in the convoy." Multiple people voiced about our signs: "people need to see this."

Oklahoma State Police counted the total number of trucks and vehicles at 7000 stretching 30 miles in length. Vehicles would join the convoy and then exit it at a later point. Along many parts of the route, people waved their arms and held flags in support of freedom and to call for an end to the now bogus the state of medical emergency that initially led to vaccine and mask mandates. Honoring a Pioneering Pro-Life Physician

Ronald Reagan changed his “pro-choice” position about abortion after he heard Dr. Mildred Fay Jefferson, M.D. give an eloquent defense for life in 1972. President Reagan had listened to her on the PBS (Boston WGPH) television program called “The Advocates” and then wrote Dr. Jefferson a letter in which he shared: “I wish I could have heard your views before the legislation was passed [Reagan was then the California governor who had signed the law making abortion legal]. You have made it irrefutably clear that an abortion is the taking of a human life, I am grateful to you.” <https://bit.ly/3quyWw1>

CBR Executive Director Gregg Cunningham met Dr. Jefferson over 40 years ago when she traveled to Pennsylvania to testify for the Abortion Control Act that he co-sponsored while serving as a Pennsylvania State Representative. He stated, “She was a woman from another age. She was kind and gentle and very intelligent.”

Dr. Jefferson was the first Black woman to graduate from Harvard Medical School (1951), the first female general surgeon to work at Boston University’s Medical Center, the first woman to become a member of the Boston Surgical Society, and more importantly, Dr. Jefferson was a leader in the founding of the modern pro-life movement. *The Harvard Crimson* published an article which stated: “Her activism quickly overshadowed her medical contributions, and she found herself at the forefront of the pro-life movement, fueling a political career that resulted in three runs for Senate.”

The Harvard Crimson cited a powerful Jefferson quote that was printed in the March/April 1972 issue of Boston University’s *Centerscope* magazine: “From conception, the complex, dynamic, developing organism-child is separate and distinct from its mother. The life process, the sum total of energy-exchange reactions, is activated by the fertilization of the ovum from the female by the sperm from the male and is manifested by progressive cell division.”



President Ronald Reagan changed to be pro-life after hearing an eloquent speech by Dr. Mildred Fay Jefferson. She was a true pro-life hero.

Dr. Jefferson served as a member of the Value of Life Committee’s board of governors, and from that she departed to form the Massachusetts Citizens for Life. She worked to mobilize members of the pro-life movement and that resulted in the founding of the National Right to Life Committee.

The Harvard Crimson quoted Dr. Jefferson as saying, “When church groups demand government funding of abortion for poor women, they are updating an old fascist model of social planning: keeping down social costs by getting rid of those who would run up the costs,” She understood the eugenics strategy

of Planned Parenthood founder Margaret H. Sanger, and her ugly campaign to target the Black population through her “Negro Project.”

Dr. Jefferson was given tribute in a video at the 41st Annual National Right to Life Convention in 2011. One of Dr. Jefferson’s quotes included in the video was: “When you believe something is wrong, you speak out. You wouldn’t stand by on a cliff and watch somebody walk off. We have to protect the weak and the helpless, the unborn.”

May God raise up more women and men to testify to the truth like Dr. Mildred Fay Jefferson.

the People’s Convoy on the 94.7 FM country radio station website. The convoy was traveling along I-44, and our truck is clearly visible at 5:31 as it rolled behind a white semi-truck in Springfield, Missouri. <https://bit.ly/3um59qs>

Our drivers stayed with the convoy all the way to Washington, D.C. *The Washington Post* reported on March 5 that there were 1000 vehicles in the convoy as it circled the Capitol Beltway. <https://wapo.st/3IC7bYu> Due to limited funding, our truck did not remain with the part of the convoy that stayed in D.C. but it returned to Arizona. In total, we logged 4700 miles on the Interstate highways. That means millions of people saw our photos and they can now make better informed decisions regarding abortion.



Pagan Hears Gospel at University of Kentucky GAP

After engaging in a debate about what it means to be human, a female student at the University of Kentucky was asked by our volunteer, “Why do we want to protect the preborn child?” When the student responded, “Why?” our volunteer shared the Gospel with her. At that point, she claimed to be a pagan. After a few minutes, volunteer Laurice stepped in to continue the conversation and we trust God that seeds were planted that will lead to her salvation.

This incident took place when our team took our Genocide Awareness Project to the University of Kentucky in Lexington on October 27-28, 2021. Our team of staff and volunteers had many opportunities to help students understand why we compare abortion to genocide.

One man claimed our photo of an aborted child’s hand was false. He had seen an ultrasound photo of his 10-week child and said his baby was only about 2 inches in length. Our volunteer explained the difference between aging the baby since conception and dating the pregnancy from the last menstrual period. Tony also showed how we used a quarter in the photo with the baby’s hand for size comparison. That took him off guard as he replied that he hadn’t noticed the quarter. The man quickly changed the subject away from the horror of the aborted baby photo and shifted his argument to claim that “only 3% of Planned Parenthood’s business is abortion.”

We are now more frequently hearing from Planned Parenthood that they should receive public funding because abortion is “only 3% of their ‘business.’” If the Holocaust was “only” 3% of the Gestapo’s “business,” would that have made their predations any less crimes against humanity? What is the rest of Planned Parenthood’s business? Selling aborted baby body parts, including organs harvested from late term babies who may or may not still be alive following their “terminations?”

In addition to chopping up the bodies of preborn children, their business involves chopping up bodies of pre-pubescent children who are being pushed into “transgender” child abuse such as chopping off the breasts of little girls who think they want to be boys, and chopping off the genitals

of little boys who think they want to be girls. And then there are the prescription sex hormones and puberty blocking drugs which offer an endless revenue stream to Planned Parenthood and associated doctors getting rich while destroying the endocrine systems of these confused children. Vladimir Putin is blowing up children’s hospitals in Ukraine. Is Planned Parenthood any less mendacious?

The good news is that the pictures travel home in the minds of people and God will work on their hearts.
