CBR Battles Planned Parenthood, Trans Terrorists and Chinese Communist Thugs







CBR has designed original photo signs, sign mounts and covers for these new Ford Transit trucks. We will begin running the trucks in California around college campuses this fall.







BR has long operated two of our large dieselpowered billboard trucks from a base in California, but the California Climate Cult bureaucrats have now forced us to replace those diesel trucks with trucks powered by gasoline engine vehicles. Please see the mockup photos above.

Those gas-powered trucks are currently being converted into billboard trucks and are about to be launched as part of a project which will target the 34 California State and University of California campuses up and down the state. The themes of several of the signs will invoke the dangers of abortion pills which are now being dispensed in student health centers on these campuses.

Many California schools are populated with large concentrations of students who are citizens of the People's Republic of China, and those students are frequently harassed by Chinese secret police agents who use intimidation tactics to deter students from posting anticommunist messaging on social media. Our signs will hit back at these thugs.

"Trans" mania is also sweeping American college campuses, and California schools are among the worst. CBR believes that consenting adults who suffer "gender dysphoria" should be free to mutilate their bodies and wreck their endocrine systems if they wish (tragic though those decisions may be), but no one has the right to mistreat children with "gender-affirming care" which is actually gender-denying abuse. Planned Parenthood is now making a fortune selling dangerous puberty-blocker drugs which do irreversible damage to children's hormone balances. They are also arranging elective mastectomies and castrations on girls and boys who are being pressured to "transition."

Nor do we believe that biological men should be permitted to menace real women in women's prisons or women's shelters. We also oppose policies which permit biological men to consistently defeat and often injure real women by invading in women's sports and posing as real women.

We demand that trans-terrorists leave women and children alone, and by God's grace, we are playing a leading role among the few pro-life groups meaningfully fighting toward that end.

One Small Step by Kent State Astronautics Major

Kent State University astronautics major took one small step during our Genocide Awareness Project (GAP). He told CBR volunteer Tony that he is pro-life, but admitted he doesn't do anything about it. He accepted a pro-life button and immediately put it on his backpack; we trust this was only the beginning for him.

On April 24-25, 2023, our GAP team conducted a display on Risman Plaza. Due to limitations imposed by the Kent State University (KSU) administration, we held our 5 x 5-foot signs rather than erect the larger signs on fixed poles. Even so, our 5-foot signs are designed to be displayed in two panels which makes each sign set 10 feet across. Their impact is substantial. Our photos compare abortion to other forms of genocide and some signs educate students about other bio-ethical abuses.

The student newspaper covered GAP with a story titled "Anti-abortion Demonstration Sparks Counter Protest on K." https://bit.ly/3P7pzzi The story attempted to discredit us by writing that our "graphic displays allegedly depict aborted fetuses." If these broken babies are not fetuses and embryos, what could they be?! Ironically, one of their photo captions stated that our banners depicted the results of abortion. It seems the person who wrote the photo caption must be on our side, or at least is honest.

KentWired reported that dozens of students "clashed" with our team. University staff told the pro-abortion students to move back from our display as the law does not permit them to cover up Constitutionally protected speech. As their numbers grew, some began to chant old pro-abortion phrases. The paper observed that: "Senior political science major Dale Chalfin, began chanting phrases such as "Racist, sexist, anti-gay, pro-life bigots, go away!" That one must be in an old pro-abortion playbook as we've heard it for years. An updated chant would certainly claim we are "transphobic."

On April 25, the second day of GAP, protesters created more drama. Some students held black umbrellas in an attempt to cover our signs. Later, they brought out bedsheets, but they still could not effectively cover up our message. We brought more signs from our truck to thwart their efforts.



Pro-abortion students at Kent State University saw our powerful photos and used umbrellas and later bedsheets in an attempt to prevent other students from seeing the truth. One student held a small sign that was especially callous: "If it doesn't pay rent it can be evicted." Pray for God to soften the hard of heart.

In their desperation, pro-abortion protestors yelled that our pictures are fake. *KentWired* interviewed CBR spokesperson Jacinta Robin as she described their actions: "The counter protesters are frustrated with what we're showing the public. We are showing decapitated, dismembered preborn children and they're frustrated that the truth of abortion is being exposed. They get really loud." Many also are frustrated that our GAP team is trained to remain calm and respectful, even when students are rude or worse. But there were many encouraging encounters with those who did not join the protest against us.

- This graduate student walked by in the morning, but came back in the afternoon to say, "I am a medical student and my textbooks confirm exactly what you are saying." She returned a second time, bringing a friend, and they joined our team in speaking up for the preborn.
- A student came up to our display to thank us for being on campus. Her words encouraged our team, and so too our presence encourages these pro-life students who are enduring a pro-abortion environment on campus. It is vital that we keep going to these colleges and universities.
- A female student stared at the GAP photos from a distance and eventually came over to talk. She told CBR staff member Amanda Levi, "Wow, this is so graphic. I have never seen anything like this before. This is so sad."

This student with a conscience is one of the millions we seek to reach on campuses across the United States. The pictures stay in their minds and they will make better decisions in the future when they become pregnant, and when they vote.
