Baby Saved by Sidewalk Counselor Using CBR Pictures

n experienced sidewalk counselor was working to save babies outside a late-term abortion operation in the Seattle area. He "spoke" with a Chinese couple who had come for an early abortion by using Google translate. They listened for forty minutes and he urged them to visit a local pregnancy center. Andrew Kerin reported, "It wasn't until I showed them the prenatal photos and abortion images from CBR that the couple chose life for their baby." Adding Audio of a Baby's Heartbeat Turns Heads in Liverpool

BR-UK added an audio track of a human fetal heartbeat to a CBR 9-week photo of a living human fetus in a display in Liverpool, England. The Liverpool team noted more passersby turned their heads towards the speaker, so more people saw the display, which also included abortion photos. his impressive new sign educates people about the amazing beauty and development of an eight-week human embryo. 90% of this baby's body systems will be present by the end of the eighth week, but they will continue to refine in their ability to function. The eight-week embryo's heartbeat has been beating for 5 weeks and its brain has produced brain waves for two weeks. Babies can be killed by the abortion pill at this age, so it is vital that we show the public the truth about prenatal development.

Powerful Prenatal Picture Projects

The brain begins to develop during the 3rd week, but from the 5th week on, a vast number of brain cells proliferate in the ventricular zone, the area which holds a protomap of the regions of the brain which will undergo future development.

Each brain cell appears to already contain the eventual "map address" to which it will migrate from the core of the brain outward to its targeted location in the cortex (thinking, reasoning, etc.), passing through a pre-programmed number of the brain's six lavers of neurons.'

Brain cells of the same type recognize one another and draw together in a highly ordered process called "aggregation," often arranging themselves in the same orientation as other cells of their type."

By the 9th month, these neurons will have formed trillions of connections ("synapses") linking themselves to one another and exchanging electro-chemical signals in the most elaborate network in the known universe."

Getting People's Heads Out of the Sand - GAP at GCC

uring our Genocide Awareness Project (GAP) at Glendale Community College Nov. 27–28, CBR Student Outreach Coordinator Cody Levi spoke with a student who was in shock. He had looked at the display for nearly 20 minutes, and then Mr. Levi approached to ask if he had questions. This student was clueless about abortion, believing abortions only took place when a woman had a life-threatening pregnancy, and he had no idea what actually happens during an abortion procedure. He was horrified to learn about late-term abortions and that most abortions are elective. He sighed heavily and told Mr. Levi he had definitely changed his mind about abortion. He sincerely thanked us for talking to him and walked away in a daze. Another student told Mr. Levi, "Man, I can't get those pictures out of my head since yesterday."

After a group of students finished asking questions of Mr. Levi, a young woman entered into a conversation with him. She confessed to him that she had an abortion recently; she was told by abortion workers that it was not a baby, and she did not know the reality of abortion. After seeing our pictures, she felt terrible about what she had done. Her first response was to justify her actions, but she eventually agreed that abortion was wrong and told Mr. Levi that she changed her mind. She had never heard of pregnancy help centers, so she took a picture of our 800 help number sign as she walked away.

CBR-Netherlands Displays Six-Week Human Embryo Photo on a Public Sign Post

e Andere Krant interviewed CBR-Netherlands Founder Salome van der Wende. The article was published November 4, 2023 and it included a photo of a sign post with a six-week human embryo picture. This sign post is in a Utrecht public square, so

many people were reached, both by the photo educating passersby plus the article containing the same photo. It is surprising that a very liberal country like the Netherlands publishes more balanced abortion articles than does the mainstream press in the U.S.
