Pastors Should Preach about the Moral Issues of Our Day

Our pastors should recognize that political issues are often also spiritual issues which require spiritual leadership for well-informed Christian voters.

Here are a few examples of moral issues of our day which cry out for bold pastoral preaching:

Transgender Child Abuse: The June 29, 2024 issue of *The Economist* magazine reports that a transgender advocacy group aggressively interfered with a study conducted by Johns Hopkins University. The interference was apparently intended to create the false impression that it can be in the best interest of little children to have their breasts chopped off, and have their genitals mutilated, and have their endocrine systems compromised (with puberty blockers and cross-sex hormones).

“Jesus said to his disciples: ‘Things that cause people to stumble are bound to come, but woe to anyone through whom they come. It would be better for them to be thrown into the sea with a millstone tied around their neck than to cause one of these little ones to stumble.’”
Luke 17:1-2

Abortion Child Sacrifice: For perspective, abortion has butchered more than 63 million American babies since 1973, and it slaughters more than 73 million globally every 12 months. Each of those numbers by itself falls within the estimates of all the people killed (military and civilian deaths) in World War II. That is more than 10 times the number of Jews killed in the Holocaust. Even more shockingly, of the 6 million Jews murdered by Adolf Hitler, 1.6 million were children. By Israel’s 80th birthday, the country will have killed 1.6 million of their own Jewish, preborn babies. Most abortions are performed with pills which can be purchased at all major pharmacies.

“They sacrificed their sons and their daughters to false gods. They shed innocent blood, the blood of their sons and daughters, whom they sacrificed to the idols of Canaan, and the land was desecrated by their blood... Therefore the Lord was angry with his people and abhorred his inheritance.” Psalm 106:37, 38a, 40

Craziness at Keswick Convention

A beautiful photo of a 9-week human fetus, alive in the womb, caused consternation at UK's historic Keswick Convention. This event has been conducted for over 100 years, and this year's convention ran from July 13 through August 2, 2024. Their website proclaims: "Christians from all over the UK and from around the world gather in Keswick to hear the Word of God and to sing God's praises, to be encouraged, inspired and equipped to love and live for Christ in His world."

But what about love for the preborn babies at risk for abortion? This year, Keswick organizers, unbelievably: 1) accused CBR-UK Christian pro-lifers of doing "damage to fellow believers," 2) called on police to silence them, and 3) Chief Executive Mark Ellis told the pro-lifers "in no uncertain terms" not to come to Keswick during the convention, and claimed "reputational damage."

These bombastic behaviors and cockamamie claims by Keswick organizers were the result of a CBR-UK sign with a beautiful 9-week preborn baby growing in the womb. Keswick organizers refused to allow CBR-UK to reserve an exhibit table inside the convention last year, so the CBR-UK Liverpool team held the preborn baby photo sign in the city center last summer, and again on July 24, 2024.

CBR-UK's Brephos Project leader Dave Brennon explained the resistance to the truth in this 2023 Instagram post: CBR UK | Another cover up, this time in Keswick this afternoon. Their refusal to tolerate scientific factual images says a lot... We are still going... | [Instagram](#)

In July 2023, Keswick Convention hosted a talk called "The Unborn Human" by Celia Wyatt. This professional counselor recommended the ill-advised, but widespread UK method called "Nondirective abortion counseling." This approach treats decisions to abort and decisions to deliver as morally equivalent. It leaves the pregnant woman and her preborn child vulnerable to abortion, so it is from the devil. Wyatt insisted that "The bitter culture wars in the US on this topic trickle over here, but it's important to recognize that the medical, social, and political context is very different in the UK." How much difference can there be since every abortion anywhere kills a child made in God's image?



Organizers of the historic Keswick Convention in England cared more about their reputation than the lives of preborn babies at risk for abortion. CBR-UK used this spectacular sign with a 9-week human fetus to educate people in the city center.

Mrs. Wyatt confused listeners as she talked out of both sides of her mouth: Psalm 139 "teaches the full humanity of the unborn child; David describes continuity between his embryonic self right through to his adult self ... Abortion is, therefore, tantamount to taking the life of the child."

But she recommends secular pregnancy centers which use "nondirective counseling," based on a humanistic technique pioneered by atheist psychologist Carl Rogers. Wyatt stated: "Client feedback consistently demonstrates appreciation for not being judged, not being told what to do, and being given time." How about showing the woman the truth about prenatal development and abortion, and urging her to make a decision that is pleasing to God?

Report from the Seven Foot Apologist

When Dan Kreft — Seven-Foot Apologist (sevenfootapologist.com) contacted us requesting abortion photos last month, he was preparing to give a conference presentation about abortion. The pastor of the Arizona church hosting the event said the biggest problems he faces in Tucson are apathy and complacency, even in his own congregation. Mr. Kreft included numerous CBR abortion photos and also prenatal images in his presentation; he learned afterwards that it shook up the attendees.

One grandmotherly lady approached Mr. Kreft and gave him a big hug because he described himself as

being “absolutely wrecked afterwards.” Many people thanked him for the presentation. Two experienced pro-life advocates (who do sidewalk counseling and street evangelism) said it was one of the best presentations on the topic that they’d ever heard.

Dan emailed a member of his own church after his presentation: “I think the problem [the pastor] has in Tucson is not limited to that area. If the body of Christ took this issue seriously and put action behind the platitudes, how long do you think this holocaust would continue in our nation? We seem, as a whole, to be more concerned about being nice than we are about waking Christians up and calling the unbelievers to repentance.”

race theory that promotes hatred among ethnic groups. Meanwhile, absenteeism and classroom disruption have risen and math, reading and history scores have fallen.

“Fix these words of mine in your hearts and minds; tie them as symbols on your hands and bind them on your foreheads. Teach them to your children, talking about them when you sit at home and when you walk along the road, when you lie down and when you get up.”

Deut. 11:18a,19

Israel: On October 7, Hamas terrorists waged the deadliest attack on Jews since the Holocaust — slaughtering babies, raping women, burning whole families alive, and taking hundreds of innocent civilians hostage.
