"Cool" Exhibit at Glendale Community College

A female student at Glendale Community College said, "This is so gross, but it's cool," when she saw CBR's prenatal science display on February 20, 2025. Although her choice of words were somewhat odd, it was apparent that this student was moved by the beautiful photographs of living preborn babies. This college in Glendale, Arizona, has many students who are responsive to our huge photo displays on their campus. The display does not reference abortion, but it educates viewers about the crisis in maternal-fetal health in the U.S. The CDC and American College of OB/GYN's are both writing about the abysmal statistics which show that outcomes for babies and their mothers are much worse than other industrialized countries. We can make a difference through this educational project, thus saving more lives. By showing the beauty and humanity of preborn children, many pregnant women will reject abortion and choose to protect their babies.

The Most Awesome Display I've Ever Seen

During our new prenatal science display at Arizona Christian College, a female student was heard saying, "This is the most awesome display I've ever seen." The new display is truly spectacular with photos of living babies in the womb from five weeks through nine months, as well as highly detailed artistic pictures of human embryos from weeks one through four. We had a warm welcome on this Christian campus in Glendale, Arizona, on March 17, 2025. The student and faculty reaction to the display was so positive. The chaplain came to see the twenty 7-foot columns and was impressed enough to give his card to CBR Executive Director Gregg Cunningham. The wife of the university president said our project is exciting and wants us to help a student start a new pro-life club.

CBR must take our prenatal and abortion photo displays to Christian venues. The statistics regarding Christians having abortions are shocking. A 2023 study of 1,093 churchgoers found: "One out of every six regular churchgoers in the United States has had, paid for or encouraged an abortion, while one-fifth doesn't believe the Bible identifies when life begins, a new study suggests." <https://bit.ly/4iPE8Dk> We understand that some of those abortions took place before churchgoers became Christians, but not all.

Pastors rarely preach about abortion, according to a 2019 Pew Research Center analysis. Pew found "that just 4% of sermons shared on U.S. church websites in the spring of 2019 discussed abortion even once – and when they did, it was rarely mentioned repeatedly. Still, pastors who broached the topic were nearly unanimous in their opposition." Few U.S. sermons mention abortion, though discussion varies by religion, congregation size. <https://bit.ly/4iCSEyE>

T-shirts with photos of preborn babies were given to students who agreed to wear them on campus. They became "walking billboards" to draw more students to see the display. We trust that many babies will be saved from abortion as a result of our time on campus.





Armed Robbers Stole CBR Abortion Video in Ghana

This surprising email arrived March 17, 2025, from J.D., a minister of Calvary Hill Church of Christ in Tarkwa, Ghana:
