Our Double Presence at Massive March For Life 2026

This may have been the largest March For Life ever in terms of the number of marchers present on January 23, 2026. The median age was also the youngest we have seen, with the majority of marchers being middle school age through college age. We are grateful that your support enabled us to conduct two different photo sign displays on both sides of Constitution Avenue. The following photos and captions will help you see what it was like, even though most of you didn't have to brave the brutally cold weather.

The Center For Bio-Ethical Reform (CBR) staff and volunteers began the setup of our prenatal exhibit at the March For Life 2026 at 7 am, although marchers do not begin to pass until approximately 1 pm. This year the normally peaceful March was made potentially dangerous by widespread anger at



President Trump's policies, and before the day ended we understood we could be made targets of this rage. One pro-abortion protester got his face about 6 inches away from CBR Executive Director Gregg Cunningham and screamed obscenities at the top of his lungs. But no one can shout down our signs. The angry protestors identified themselves as ANTIFA, the same group attacking immigration officers in Minneapolis.

We therefore requested police protection and received a heavy law enforcement presence outside the National Gallery of Art.

The Gallery initially attempted to deny us permission to display our pictures on the public sidewalk, but after several email exchanges with the Gallery’s attorneys, these left-wing bureaucrats backed down. They folded when we sent them a court order documenting the victory we achieved when we sued the Black History Museum in Federal Court for also attempting to bar our display outside their facility in 2017.

Our longtime attorney, Rob Muisse (American Freedom Law Center), was our lead counsel on that previous case, and the 2017 victory forced the government to relent again in 2026.

We also enlisted the aid of Congressman Tim Burchett, (R-TN), whose district includes our Knoxville, TN office, and his excellent staff helped coordinate successful negotiations with the Gallery.

Before the start of the March For Life, we photographed our prenatal display on Constitution Avenue with the magnificent Capitol Building in the background. Our powerful embryonic and fetal imagery panels were accompanied by 20 inspiring scripture references (see the smaller A-frame signs in the foreground) describing the processes by which

God creates us in His image. We always include a large television monitor which displays endoscopic video footage of actual embryos and fetuses, alive and moving in their mothers’ wombs.

Here is another view of our display with the Capitol visible in the background. The 20- column display depicts

prenatal development in wireframe size comparisons (still images derived from our endoscopic video scans) during weeks 1-12 and months 4-9.

On the other side of Constitution Avenue, we showed marchers what abortion does to the beautiful babies they had just passed at our prenatal science exhibit. This display is explicitly anti-abortion, and it inveighs against abortion pills, with a caption which reads “DON’T FEED YOUR BABY TO THE SEWER RATS.” This is an obvious reference to the fact that most of these mothers abort on the toilet and then flush their perhaps still living baby into the sewer.

As we began this setup, we realized that the very violent ANTIFA group had been assigned a display area contiguous with ours. ANTIFA stands for “anti-fascist,” but they are violently fascist despite their disingenuous claim to oppose fascism. Their largest sign said “F - Trump,” and they harassed passersby all day.

Their attacks on immigration officers in Minneapolis and elsewhere have resulted in the deaths of protesters, and they immediately began to menace our staff, placing a large sign in front of our display to cover up our messaging.

They also shouted threats which motivated me to withdraw our staff to a safer location across the street once our display was up and running. At my request, the Capitol Police flooded the zone with even more officers in front of our exhibit.

The March was extremely well attended, and many marchers took photos of our exhibit. Our primary audience is young people, and they participated in large numbers.

The crowds in 2026 were among the largest ever observed at a March For Life, and by God’s grace, our two exhibits had a powerful impact.
